#### TAX COLLECTION INFORMATION

ALL PROPERTY TAXES ARE TO BE MAILED OR DROPPED IN LOCKED DROPBOX THIS YEAR. THE LOCKED DROPBOX IS LOCATED AT THE END OF THE MAIN ENTRANCE HALLWAY OF THE TOWN HALL.

#### Make all checks payable to Town of Milford.

Send tax stub and personal or cashier check to treasurer. Separate checks for real estate or personal property taxes, and dog licenses are required.

First installment must be received and/or postmarked by January 31, 2023.



Balance due on 2<sup>nd</sup> half must be sent and paid to John Jensen, Jefferson County Treasurer, 311 South Center St., Jefferson, WI 53549 by July 31, 2023.

# DOG LICENSES DUE BEFORE APRIL 1, 2023

Please license your dog(s) when paying your taxes if possible.

A \$5.00 penalty for each dog is issued after the deadline.

## Rabies certificates must be sent with the application.

STATE LAW REQUIRES ALL DOGS BE LICENSED! State law requires all dogs over 5 months be inoculated against rabies. It must be stated on your rabies certificate if the dog is spayed or neutered. It will be returned with your license.

### FIRE NUMBER SIGNS

Please make arrangements for replacement of your fire number sign. If the signs are 1 emergency vehicles might be unable to locate your residence. The Board is concerned about the safety issue involved with fading signs and is ordering signs for citizens that request a new one. We are charging \$5.00 for a new sign with the township paying the remaining balance of the cost. The township will arrange for putting the new signs up. Signs will be ordered in groups.

If you would like a new fire number sign, you will need to contact the Treasurer and send a \$5.00 payable to the Town of Milford and send to Kathy Redmer, Treasurer to order a new one. The \$5.00 fee will be due upon placement of your order.

### CURBSIDE AND RECYCLING NEWS

Included with this letter, is a flyer from GFL. The flyer contains information on what can and cannot be recycled along with a calendar for our pickups. Our recycling is picked up every other week on the same day as trash pickup. They pick up trash every week. Be sure to check the calendar for the holiday schedules as well as bulk pick up dates. If it is a holiday where they do not have pickup, GFL will be coming the following day. Please be sure to recycle the items that are listed on the flyer. Keep carts at least three feet apart and away from other objects such as mail boxes, light poles, cars, etc. All bulk and appliance pickup requests must be scheduled in advance. A listing of what bulk pickup consists of is on the flyer. Call GFL at 800-248-2373 to schedule a pickup date for large items or appliances. There is no charge for a scheduled bulk pickup.

Bulk pickup is not intended for complete cleanout of buildings or construction materials, etc. For such purposes, it is necessary for you to arrange for rental of a dumpster.

### Planting In Road Right-Of-Way

When planting new trees, shrubs, etc. on your property, please consider visibility of the road. The placement of these plantings may not be a problem now, but look into the future. Utility lines are also a consideration. If there is an existing visibility problem, please trim and/or remove offending trees, shrubs, etc so that the roads are safer for everyone.

### Downed Trees In Road Right-Of-Way

When a tree that is on your property falls within the Road Right-of-Way the property owner may be liable for any/all expenses that it costs the township to remove. It is the property owner's responsibility to have these removed.

### Damage to Township Roads

Please be aware that the repair of any damage from any vehicle done to the road surface, shoulder, or right of way of any township road is the responsibility of the operator of said vehicle.

### **NOXIOUS WEEDS**

Please remember that it is your responsibility to keep noxious weeds, including thistles, cut or sprayed on your parcels. Your help with this will be greatly appreciated. The Town Board wishes to thank all residents who have kept the ditches bordering their property mowed and maintained. As a reminder, blowing any grass clippings into a township road is unsafe and unlawful. Thank you for helping to keep our township beautiful and safe!
